Schemenauer      three-digit suicide and crisis hotline;

AND WHEREAS the ongoing COVID- 19 pandemic has increased the demand for  
suicide prevention services by 200 per cent;  
AND WHEREAS existing suicide prevention hotlines require the user to remember  
a 10-digit number and go through directories or placed on hold;

AND WHEREAS in 2022 the United States will have in place a national 988  
crisis hotline;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Lake Lenore recognizes that it is a  
significant and important initiative to ensure critical barriers are removed to those  
in a crisis and seeking help;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Village of Lake Lenore endorses this  
988 crisis line initiative;

And that Clerk Connie Cordero be directed to send a letter indicating such support to  
MP Kelly Block, MP Todd Doherty, the Provincial Minister of Health, the Federal  
Minister of Health, and the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications  
Commission to indicate our support.




Good afternoon,
